

2016-2017 Dance Theatre Studio Shoe Guidelines

The recommended shoes **do not** need to be purchased for the first day of class. Please have your child use his/her current shoes until replacement is necessary!

We do require that students have the listed styles for recital.

Preschool Movement 1: Girls- Pink Ballet Slippers
Boys- Black Ballet Slippers

Preschool Movement 2: Girls- Pink Ballet Slippers and Tan Mary-Jane Tap Shoes
Boys- Black Ballet Slippers and Black Lace Up Tap Shoes

Ballet (All Levels): Girls- Pink Ballet Slippers
Boys- Black Ballet Slippers

Tap 3-7: Girls- Tan Mary-Jane Tap Shoes
Boys- Black Lace Up Tap Shoes

Tap C1 & C2: Girls- Black Lace Up Tap Shoes
Boys- Black Lace Up Tap Shoes

Tap C3 & C4: Girls- Tan High Heeled Tap Shoes (will discuss in class)*
Boys- Black Lace Up Tap Shoes

Jazz (All Levels): Girls- Tan Jazz Boot (no laces)
Boys- Black Jazz Boot (no laces)

Hip Hop 5-7 and Teen Hip Hop: Girls-Silver Sequin Sneakers
Boys- Black Low Top Converse style Sneakers*

Hip Hop C1: Girls- Silver Sequin Sneakers
Boys- Black Low Top Converse style Sneakers*

Hip Hop C2: Girls- Pastry Glam Pie Glitter Sneakers in black* (Discount Dance often has best price on these)
Boys- "Rieder Sneakers" by Airwalk in black* (ones with white rubber)

Hip Hop C3 & C4: Girls & Boys: Unisex Dance Work Boot- come up to the office to try them on and figure out your size. We will then order for the entire class and hand them out as soon as they come in!

Contemporary (All Levels): Dancers may wear jazz shoes, dance paws, or bare feet for class. Information for performance footwear will be discussed in class.

Modern: Dancers should be barefoot, no shoes are necessary.
